



Shout out to "Broadway Estates"

In reviewing some of the SGCC surveys that came through the civic association's post office box, there were several returned from people who live on the north side of Arapahoe Road. They made comments to the effect that they felt they were not part of Southglenn. This couldn't be further from the truth. The residences on the north side of Arapahoe were the first houses to be built by Southglenn's developer, Perl-Mack. They are designated "Southglenn 1st Flag." The next area developed was south of Arapahoe, just south and east of the Baptist Church at Washington. The development moved east from there toward High Street. Then, south between Franklin and Clarkson, finishing up in the southwest corner near Washington and Dry Creek. I'm sure when Southglenn was developed, Arapahoe didn't seem like quite the divide it is today. Please don't feel that the activities coordinated by the Southglenn Civic Association do not apply to you. They most certainly do. We make sure the newsletter is delivered to your houses every month. But we also coordinate numerous functions that absolutely include you and for which your dues would be greatly appreciated.

I'm not sure how many of you are on Nextdoor. When I created the "Southglenn" neighborhood, someone from Broadway Estates had already drawn the boundaries for Broadway Estates and included all of your houses. I tried to work with Nextdoor and the lead for Broadway Estates, but was not able to get the borders changed. If you feel strongly about it, you can contact the lead and/or Nextdoor and ask them to have the border changed.



Investment in Community

Steph Maxey from the Southglenn Country Club board of directors reviewed the survey results with us at our last Civic Association meeting. She reviewed the general themes of feedback, with a big one being the prohibitive cost of membership for many residents. While delivering the newsletter with the survey, several of our board members received feedback from neighbors that they could no longer participate in activities at the club, but would like to provide some sort of financial assistance to the club and weren't sure how best to go about it. These points of feedback lead to a brainstorming session of how best the Civic Association could help to address both of these issues. We came up with the idea to administer a "sponsorship" program for Country Club memberships. If you would like to provide some financial assistance to the club, would you consider writing a check to the Southglenn Civic Association for that purpose? The Civic Association will create a committee that will seek to match donated funds with those needing funds for membership. Donors win with the knowledge that they have both financially supported the Country Club as well as given a tremendous opportunity to a neighbor to create what will hopefully be many fond memories of time spent at the club. The Country Club wins by garnering new memberships and the opportunity to turn them into continual revenue stream. The Civic Association wins by increasing participation of Southglenn residents at the Club - less than 10% of Southglenn households are current members.

We will be providing more information in next month's newsletter about how residents can apply for financial assistance for a membership. Applications will be due by early May. The committee will evaluate the requests for funds relative to the funds raised and try to maximize memberships. The goal will be to have all funds disbursed for membership before the pool opens over Memorial Day weekend.

If you'd like to contribute funds toward this endeavor, please send a check to the Southglenn Civic Association and note that it is for "SGCC program." If you haven't paid your dues yet, write one check with note that "excess is for SGCC program." Thank you for your consideration.


