A REPUBLIC IF YOU CAN KEEP IT...

This column is the regular place where once a month you can get a little bit of very focused micropolitics. We do not examine normal partisan politics, but instead focus on the issues facing the local community.

City Council approved a 6-month moratorium on building pickleball courts within 500 feet of residential neighborhoods. The issue passed in an 8-1 vote in the council hearing on 3/21. This issue has arisen based primarily on Lifetime Fitness proposing to build courts within 300 feet of the Mira Vista and Heritage Greens neighborhoods.

The SGCA will be leaving CENCON effective 4/1. Our neighborhood has had a fraught relationship with CenCON ever since the organization stated its approval for the expansion of apartments at The Streets of SoughGlenn against the wishes of our membership. Leaving the organization, which only has an active membership of perhaps 20 out of the 190 recognized neighborhoods in Centennial, will allow us to focus on areas where we agree and not have to deal with each other on areas of disagreement.

The City's "Housing Team" has selected four strategies that the city will explore in 2023 to address "affordable housing". Check out the substack for far more detailed information. Cutting to the heart of the matter. Proposition



123 created a pot of money that cities can apply for from the state. The city wants some of that money, but it must jump through some hoops. The four strategies that they have selected are: Expedited Review (basically they can build apartments without any public hearings), Accessory Dwelling Units (alley or carriage houses), Inclusionary Zoning (a shoehorn to make it easier to replace commercial property with apartments, we have the audio, really, you have to go to the substack) and lastly Land Banking (an idea so bad even CenCON hates it). What you won't see on this list is down payment assistance, which is the preferred option that the SGCA and other civic associations have endorsed.

Your ballot for this fall's SouthGlenn Country Club election will be included in your monthly SouthGlenn Living. This is a win-win for the country club and the neighborhood as it saves money for the club and will increase participation in the election.

Speaking of elections, the South Suburban Parks and Recreation board will be having an election to fill two of


the board's slots. There are six candidates and the top two vote getters will win the election. The election is on May 2nd. Look to the substack for more information and a link to the election website. This is one of those elections where your vote can really count as normally only a few thousand votes are cast.

Property tax going up! According to official projections, the average property tax bill will increase by 36% over the next few years. If your assessed home value on your last bill was \$500K then you probably had a tax bill of close to \$3,400. Look for that to go up to about \$4,625.

APRIL GARDENING CALENDAR

April is a busy gardening month and the beginning of the planting season. When soil has thawed - Divide and transplant summer and fall blooming perennials. Label your plants as you plant and subdivide. Plant trees, shrubs and vines. If you purchase bare root plants, soak them in water for several hours before planting.



Lawns: To grow a beautiful lawn, begin with aeration. If weather is warm and dry water one inch a week. This is prime time to examine your irrigation system. Check for leaks or problems with sprinkler heads. Examine the lines and emitters to be sure everything is working in drip irrigation.

If you're planning to try soaker hoses in your garden choose a sunny day to lay out the curled-up hose. It's much easier to set in place once the hose has relaxed. Also, put some sort of markers along the soaker hose so you won't slice into it when planting. I use colorful golf tees.

Weeds: These persistent survivors seemed to come up earlier than usual this year. Hand pull the young ones before they get too big... or too many.

Late freeze damage to trees and shrubs: If we get a sudden freeze and new, emerging leaves wilt and look brown wait at least a week to see if new growth emerges. Frozen plant tissue is soft and wet and vulnerable to infection if it's 'open.' If a branch fails to revive it may be necessary to prune again.
