The results of the "State of the 'Glenn" 2022 survey are in. Thank you to everyone that participated.

Big takeaways: The respondents strongly disapproved of the public financing of the Streets at Southglenn and the decision to change it from retail to rental properties. This mirrors the disapproval that residents voiced in the outreach that the City did before council unanimously approved the changes.

Who's on first? Residents don't seem to know who Mayor Piko is. Council Member Moon is either unknown or disliked by residents.



PROJECT TO FINISH RIVER ROCK ON DRY CREEK FROM CLARKSON TO FRANKLIN

The SGCA requested proposals to finish the river rock along the north side of Dry Creek (the southern edge of the neighborhood) from the edge of St. Timothy's to Franklin St. The City of Centennial was soliciting for applications to its Community Grant program for 2022. This is the same program we won last year to secure the installation of the monument signs. AWSquared

Construction was kind enough to give us a free bid to install the rock. The bid came in just a tad under \$50,000. \$50,000 is too much for the grants so we have a petition to try and get City Council to take on the project.
